

Hong Kong PhD Fellowship 2024/25



Established in 2009 by the Research Grants Council (RGC), the **Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme** (**HKPFS**) aims at attracting the best and brightest students in the world to pursue their PhD programmes in Hong Kong's universities.

What the Fellowship and CityU Offer?

In HKPFS 2024/25, each Fellowship recipient will receive:

- A monthly stipend of HK\$27,600 (approximately US\$3,538)
- A conference and research-related travel allowance of HK\$13,800 (approximately US\$1,760) per year for a maximum of three years
- An additional entrance scholarship of HK\$89,496 (approximately US\$11,473) covering tuition and on-campus hostel accommodation fees for the first year of studies
- · Additional financial subsidies/awards supported by RGC may be given to eligible Fellowship recipients

Entrance Requirements

Applicants seeking admission to PhD studies at CityU should satisfy the following minimum entrance requirements:

- Hold a higher degree by research (or equivalent qualification) from a recognised university; or
- Hold a Master's degree (or equivalent qualification) from a recognised university; or
- Hold a Bachelor's degree with first class honours (or equivalent qualification) from a recognised university.

English Proficiency Requirements

Applicants from an institution where the language of teaching is not English should satisfy the following minimum proficiency requirements:

- A minimum total score of 79 in one single internet-based test (sum of Reading, Listening and Writing section scores) in TOEFL*; or
- A minimum overall band score of 6.5 in IELTS*.

*TOEFL and IELTS scores are considered valid for two years from the test date and must be valid at the time of submission of application to CityU.
